Fuel index prices have increased from \$2.6813 per gallon for the base period to \$5.03033 per gallon current price. Proposed changes are to add a Special Fuel Surcharge Supplement No. 8 in the amount of 0.41%. 3. The temporary 0.41% fuel surcharge in all rates and charges is the result of increased fuel costs incurred by the company during the months of August, September and October 2023, to be collected from customers as follows:

For customers who are billed monthly for services in arrears, the fuel surcharge applies to all services provided in the months of December 2023, January 2024, and February 2024.
