MDJ Contractors current rates are as follows:

- \$77.50 per hour per field employee
- \$163 per hour for our owner
- \$56 per hour per pickup truck for travel time (in addition to employee rate)

Based on these rates we would anticipate charging \$1,090 to turn on the Grasslands irrigation system and \$764 to turn it off. Please note that these estimates do not include any breaks or other issues that may come up and only cover uneventful operations.

This estimate for turn on would include two hours of travel time and six hours of labor for the owner. This labor would include checking all customers ball valves, greasing pumps, disassembly, cleaning and checking screens and filters, reinstallation of filter pressure lines that were removed for winter, turning back on main power, pressure setup on the pump control computer, pump priming, slow filling of the main lines, bleeding air from the system, checking for leaks, etc.

The estimate for turn off would include two hours of travel time and four hours of labor for the owner. This labor would include preparing pumps, filters, and screens for winter, turning off power, draining the main lines, draining filters and screens, shutting down the pump control computer, disconnecting minor pumphouse water lines, and closing up the pump house for the year.
