The purpose of this substitute filing is to correct a scrivener’s error in the tariff sheets listed above. Additionally, this substitute filing corrects a sentence on Page 3 of the cover letter which stated, “...PSE has set the residential Flex incentives at a lower rate to encourage electric residential customers to enroll in this new service by offering a higher credit for participation.”

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The sentence was intended to read "...PSE has set the Peak Time Savings incentives at a lower rate to encourage electric residential customers to enroll in PSE Flex which offers a higher incentive credit as well as more opportunities for participation."

The tariff sheets described herein reflect the original issue date of September 30, 2025 and the original effective date of November 1, 2025. Posting of proposed tariff changes, as required by law and the Commission's rules and regulations, is being completed through web, telephone and mail access in accordance with WAC 480-100-193.
