On July 27, 1992, the Washington Natural Gas Company ("company") filed with the Commission under its Advice No. 373-F488, certain revisions to its currently effective Tariff WN U-2, effective August 27, 1992. The Commission entered its Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revisions in the above captioned and docketed matter on August 19, 1992, pending public hearings on the proposed changes and their justness and reasonableness.

In connection with such proceedings, the Commission deems it necessary in order to carry out the duties imposed upon it by law to investigate the books, accounts, practices, and activities of the company and to investigate and appraise various phases of the company's operations.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED That an investigation of the books, accounts, practices, and activities of the company, and a valuation and appraisal of the company's property and operations be conducted, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the company pay the expenses reasonably attributable and allocable to the investigation, valuation, and appraisal, to the extent that requiring payment is consistent with chapter 80.28 RCW, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the company shall provide the statement required by WAC 480-80-125 to its customers in the form and manner specified in the rule.
