Thank you for taking the time to meet with Dave Zabell, City Administrator and me at the City of Marysville.

We discussed the City's pending request for the opening of 5th Street with the City Council during the Council meeting on November 14th. There was a unanimous decision to request a Public Hearing for 5th Street.

It is also the desire of the Council to keep the two (2) issues of a high speed train and the 5th Street opening request separate. They suggested two separate Hearings, even if held the same evening.

Council's preference was to hold both Hearings on the same date. If that was not possible, they requested that the Hearing for the 5th Street opening be held first.
