#### **BACKGROUND**

- 1 Charter and excursion carrier services operating in the state of Washington, subject to regulation by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission), must file and maintain proof of liability and property damage insurance.
- On February 1, 2011, the Commission notified you by letter that your certificate to operate as a charter and excursion carrier service in Washington would be suspended if your insurance company did not file with the Commission acceptable proof of insurance. We also informed you that you could contest suspension of your certificate by requesting a hearing within 10 days of receiving the notice.
- 3 The Commission has not received proof of insurance and you have not requested a hearing.

#### FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

- 4 (1) The Commission is an agency of the State of Washington with authority to regulate charter and excursion carrier services as defined in RCW 81.70.

- 9 (1) Certificate CH-63835, held by Cascade Adventures, Inc. is suspended for a period of 30 days effective March 8, 2011.
- (2) Cascade Adventures, Inc. is directed to cease all operations associated with this certificate CH-63835 until the Commission receives proof of liability and property damage insurance and enters an order lifting this suspension and authorizing you to resume operations.
- 11 (3) If proof of insurance is not filed with the Commission within 30 days, certificate CH-63835 will be cancelled without further notice or order. To reinstate this certificate you must submit a new application and acceptable proof of insurance.
- 12 (4) Cascade Adventures, Inc. may contest cancellation of certificate CH-63835 by requesting a hearing within 10 days of service of this Order. A hearing request does not affect the suspension status of your certificate.


