Background and Summary

On September 6, 2019, the Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) initiated an investigation to determine whether Puget Sound Energy (PSE) complied with RCW 80.28 and WAC 480-110, regarding the public utility tax exemption to Lummi Nation tribal members (Tribe) living on tribal lands. On September 23, 2020, Commission staff (Staff) filed its final investigative report which recommended, among other things, that PSE participate in a workgroup with Staff, the Department of Revenue, the Tribe and other interested stakeholders to establish a process for certifying the tax exempt status for PSE customers.
