Company proposes to change Tariff Number 10

The company requests Commission approval to amend its filed Tariff Number 10 on Less Than Statutory Notice to increase its Special Fuel Surcharge Tariff Supplement to recover the rising cost of fuel. Fuel index prices have increased from \$3.2655 per gallon for the base period to \$5.0530 per gallon current price. The proposed change is to implement a 0.31% surcharge in Supplement 5. Supplement 4 expired on November 30, 2023. The company request less than statutory notice allowing the customers to be noticed on the first bill as previously allowed per WAC 480-70-271(2)(a).

1. The Commission finds good cause to support the request and authorize the proposed changes to become effective with Less Than Statutory Notice on: May 1, 2026.
2. The proposed changes will expire on: June 30, 2026.
3. The temporary 0.31% fuel surcharge in all rates and charges is the result of increased fuel costs incurred by the company during the months of February 2026, and March 2026, to be collected from customers as follows:

Customers who are billed monthly for services in arrears: The fuel surcharge applies to all services provided in the months of May 2026 and June 2026.

Customers who are billed bi-monthly for services – current month and one month in advance:

Customers Billed in Month end:	Fuel Surcharge applies to all services provided in the months of:
May 31, 2026	May 2026, and June 2026
June 30, 2026	June 2026, and July 2026
