ACCRA Cost of Living Index Methodology (Source: COLI.org)

The ACCRA Cost of Living Index is designed to provide the best possible means to compare cost of living differences among urban areas based on the price of consumer goods and services appropriate for professional and managerial households in the top income quintile.

The Cost of Living Index rests on the premise that prices collected at a specified time, in strict conformance with standard specifications, provide a sound basis for constructing a reasonably accurate gauge of relative differences in the cost of consumer goods and services.

Consumer expenditures cover an almost limitless range of goods and services, and no index of consumer buying can encompass all of them. Since we can't price everything, what do we do? The standard approach, used in the ACCRA Index, is to divide consumer expenditures into categories, and then select items that represent those categories. The items used in the ACCRA Index thus are surrogates for entire categories of consumer spending. For this approach to work, price differences among urban areas for the items in the Index must accurately reflect differences for the categories they represent.

The ACCRA Cost of Living Index consists of six major categories: grocery items, housing, utilities, transportation, health care, and miscellaneous goods and services. These major categories in turn are composed of subcategories, each of which is represented by one or more items in the Index. Separate component indexes are published for each of the six major categories. We're not concerned with the extent to which consumers actually purchase the individual items in the Index. The 60 items have been chosen solely to show interarea price differences in the categories they represent. What's important, in calculating the Index, is the ratio of an urban area's average price to the average price of the same item nationwide. When we use a pound of whole frying chicken to represent poultry products, we're assuming that if an area's price for this item is 10% above the nationwide average, its prices for poultry products as a whole also are about 10% above the nationwide average.

How much the ratio for each item contributes to the Index is determined by the distribution of consumer expenditures among the categories covered by the Index. The share of consumer spending devoted to the category each item represents determines that category's importance, or weight, in the Index. The ACCRA Cost of Living Index Committee has adopted the weights based on the latest data from the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics' Consumer Expenditure Survey, using the data on the proportional distribution of expenditures by households in which the reference person has a professional or managerial occupation and by households in the upper quintile of income.

Data published for the first three quarters is based on prices submitted by all participating areas. Beginning in February 2008, C2ER began publishing an annual average survey compiled from data submitted in those previous quarters. For urban areas where we have data less than three pricing periods, we developed estimated prices in order to have a complete set of observations. Thus, to calculate the annual average index, we use the actual and estimated prices as our observations to calculate an annual average price for each item. We do not weight any of the prices based on when we observe them. Thus, first pricing period prices receive the same weight in the calculation as third pricing period prices. Then, from the annual average price for each item, we calculate the index using the same BLS Consumer Expenditure Survey weights that we would for any other pricing period.

Price Reporting:

C2ER stringently reviews all prices reported, and attempts to eliminate errors and noncompliance with pricing specifications. All price data are obtained from sources deemed reliable, but no representation is made as to the complete accuracy thereof. They are published subject to errors, omissions, changes, and withdrawals without notice.

Exclusion of Taxes:

C2ER is fully cognizant that state and local taxes are an integral part of the cost of living, and that tax burdens vary widely not only among states and metropolitan areas, but even within each metropolitan area. Due to the multiplicity of state and local taxes, taxing jurisdictions, and assessment procedures, it is not feasible to calculate local tax burdens reliably. C2ER has opted to produce an index which adequately measures differences in goods and services costs, rather than to produce an inaccurate measure which attempts to incorporate taxes levied on real and intangible property, retail sales, and income.

COLI Data Interpretation:

The ACCRA Cost of Living Index measures relative price levels for consumer goods and services in participating areas. The average for all participating places, both metropolitan and nonmetropolitan, equals 100, and each participant's index is read as a percentage of the average for all places.

The Index does not measure inflation (price change over time). Because each quarterly report is a separate comparison of prices at a single point in time, and because both the number and the mix of participants may change from one quarter to the next, index data from different quarters cannot be compared. For inflation data contact the nearest regional office of the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Because the number of items priced is limited, it is not valid to treat percentage differences between areas as exact measures. Since judgement sampling is used in this survey, no confidence interval can be determined. Small differences should not be construed as significant, or even as indicating correctly which area is the more expensive place to live.

How to Use the ACCRA Cost of Living Index:

Assume that City A has a composite index of 98.3 and City B has a composite index of 128.5. If you live in City A and are contemplating a job offer in City B, how much of an increase in your after-tax income is needed to maintain your present lifestyle? $100 * [(City B - City A) / City A] = 100 * (.3072) = 30.72\%$ Increase Conversely, if your are considering a move from City B to City A, how much of a cut in after-tax income can you sustain without reducing your midmanagement lifestyle? $100 * [(City A - City B) / City B] = 100 * (-.2350) = 23.5\%$ Decrease

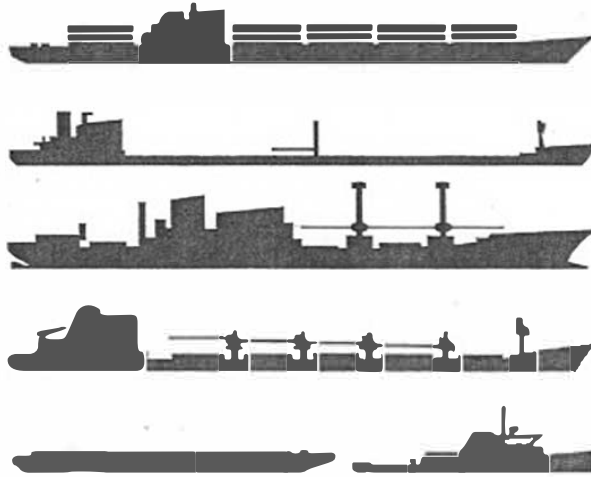

Cost of Living and Income Comparisons

Over the past several years, PSP has repeatedly referred to the high income levels in San Francisco. As stated previously, the run away income levels in San Francisco were based upon four year tariff adjustments of 6%, 6%, 4%, 4%. These tariff adjustments led to a dramatic increase in income and a "tariff freeze" for 48 months -- the freeze is currently in effect. As illustrated by the chart PMSA recently provided comparing Income to Tariff to CPI, income is growing at a much faster rate than either tariff or CPI changes. This was particularly true in San Francisco. As a result, the SF tariff freeze could potentially be extended even longer given the high income levels that have been generated by the current tariff there.

Given PSP's propensity for referring to San Francisco, there had to be some attempt to provide context for comparison not only to San Francisco but to other areas as well. As a result, PMSA presented cost of living comparison data in the past two contested tariff hearings. PMSA included other west coast cities in order to provide additional context for income comparisons.

For this education effort, we have provided current comparisons. We don't have the 2007 income levels for PSP but based on monthly revenue figures, we fully expect the personal income levels will be significantly higher than PSP, PMSA or the Pilot Commission anticipated during discussions at the tariff hearing just 9 months ago. We will all find out when the audited financials are presented. So for this effort, we had to choose an income level for PSP and we decided to use the PMSA proposal last year of a 2% tariff increase which was estimated to generate a reported gross income of \$346,392. This gross income figure was based on an estimated reported net income of \$303,838 and a PSP internal decision to set Individual Business Expense at \$42,554.68. This gross income figure does not consider the transportation allowance which includes an undetermined amount of income given the IRS limits on transportation expenses. So let's look at some comparisons.

Seattle compared to San Francisco: \$346,392.68 of Seattle income is equivalent to \$514,932.35 of income in San Francisco. The percent increase from Seattle to San Francisco necessary to maintain the same standard of living is 48.66%.

Seattle compared to LA/LB: \$346,392.68 of Seattle income is equivalent to \$477,766.65 of income in LA/LB. The percent increase from Seattle to LA/LB necessary to maintain the same standard of living 37.93%.

Note: this would mean that PSP individual pilot income level would be three times the amount of a new LA Pilot.

Seattle compared to San Diego: \$346,392.68 of Seattle income is equivalent to **\$451,662.48** of income in San Diego. The percent increase from Seattle to San Diego necessary to maintain the same standard of living 30.39%.

Seattle compared to Honolulu HI: \$346,392.68 of Seattle income is equivalent to **\$490,412.32** of income in Honolulu. The percent increase from Seattle to Honolulu necessary to maintain the same standard of living 41.58%.

Note 1: There are other adjustments that need to be considered in order to make an apples to apples comparison. For example, LA has a city retirement plan that pilots contribute 6% to. LB pilots (JPS) have a 401k retirement plan that pilots contribute to. All three pilot groups in Alaska, the pilot group in Hawaii and the pilot group in San Diego have SEP-IRA's where pilots as independent contractors, self contribute to a retirement plan with contributions being tax deferred – the current maximum contribution is \$46,000 per year. Since Puget Sound Pilots have SEP-IRA available to them and are almost certainly taking advantage of that option, some adjustment would be necessary prior to comparing to those areas that don't have additional retirement plan payments like PSP provides to members.

Note 2: California has a state income tax of 9.30% which further erodes disposable income of California pilots. Taxes are not included in the cost of living data however tax differences do impact take home pay and have to be considered in any apples to apples comparison.
