Verizon Northwest Inc. ("Verizon") has discovered its supplemental panel testimony of January 26, 2004 contains errors resulting from a misalignment of wire center CLLI codes and the geographical names in Verizon's source materials. Verizon is enclosing herewith a corrected list of these wire center names. This correction does not involve any change to Verizon's underlying deaveraging proposal or methodology. For the convenience of the parties and the Commission, Verizon is also implementing this correction in CLLI codes and name matches in its deaveraging workpapers included with its filing.

The revised workpapers also include a correction to the current tariffed zones and rates associated with each wire center CLLI. Verizon's deaveraging proposal did not rely on this current tariffed zone and rate information, and is thus unaffected by this change. However, the corrected information has been reflected in the revised workpapers, in the event that other parties wish to use this information in subsequent filings. We are filing the corrected work papers in a zip file with the electronic version of this letter.
