The Commission Staff has reviewed the issues list and believes that, with the exception of "deaveraged 2/4 wire loops" and "sub loops," none of the issues in the left-hand column remain with respect to Qwest. All of the issues in the left-hand column remain for Verizon, except those that originally were relevant only to Qwest. Staff has not reviewed the non-recurring issues, which appear in the right-hand column.
