## TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

This letter is to inform you of the progress made in the Commission's rulemaking to consider rules for Passenger Transportation Companies, chapter 480-30-WAC. This letter also provides notice of an opportunity to file written comments on proposed rules and participate in the formal rule adoption hearing.

On February 15, 2006, the Commission filed a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (CR-102) in this docket with the Code Reviser. The proposal would repeal all current rules in chapter 480-30 WAC (except WAC 480-30-999, which is revised), repeal all rules in chapter 480-40 WAC, and consolidate requirements for passenger transportation companies, including auto transportation companies, passenger charter, and excursion carriers into a single chapter by rewriting and reorganizing chapter 480-30 WAC and including provisions formerly contained in Chapter 480-40. This action begins the final part of the rulemaking process, which includes a written comment period, a public adoption hearing, and a decision by the Commission.
