BACKGROUND

- On January 31, 2001, the Commission entered its Thirteenth Supplemental Order (Part A Order) in this proceeding resolving issues relating to certain compliance filings. The Part A requires Verizon Northwest, Inc., to submit certain compliance filings by February 21, 2001.
- Verizon, on February 21, 2001 filed Advice No. 972 tariff revisions for its Tariff No. WN U-20. These included the following pages:

Commission Staff has reviewed the Company's compliance tariff filing and states that it appears to comply in all substantive respects with the Commission's Order. Several parties jointly seek clarification regarding Verizon's use of the symbol "(R)" in its compliance collocation filing. WAC 480-80-370 lists symbols to be used by all

utilities to indicate the purpose and effect of tariff material submitted to the Commission. Verizon's use of symbols is consistent with Commission rules.

The Commission finds that the tariff revisions filed with the Commission by Verizon Northwest, Inc., on February 21, 2001, are consistent with the Commission's Thirteenth Supplemental Order and therefore concludes that the tariff revisions should be approved as filed to be effective on the date this order is entered.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS That:

- The tariff revisions filed by Verizon on February 21, 2001, in accordance with the Thirteenth Supplemental Order in this proceeding, shall become effective as filed on the date this order is entered.
- THE COMMISSION ORDERS FURTHER That it retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to effectuate the provisions of this and prior orders in these proceedings.
