RESPONSE:

Public Counsel objects to this request as unclear and burdensomely broad; the term, "asset transfer transaction," is not defined and is overly broad. Without waiving this objection, public counsel provides the following response:

Each of the telecommunications merger transactions that Dr. Roycroft has addressed in docketed proceedings has introduced a substantial degree of risk. However, each transaction had unique risks that required varied responses to mitigate the risks.
