SPIC's Lottery System for Selecting New Customers

UTC STAFF DATA REQUEST NO. 29:

In Sandy Point Improvement Company's response to Staff Data Request 6, the Company refers to a "lottery" the Company uses to add new customers to its system (i.e., via new service connections).

Please explain in detail how the lottery works, including who is eligible to participate (e.g., Class A shareholder, Class C shareholder, non-shareholder, other), applicable charges, how a person "wins" the lottery and why a lottery is needed (or, if a lottery is not "needed", then why a lottery is used). In your explanation, please specifically indicate whether non-shareholders are eligible for the lottery, and if so, whether the lottery treats all participants equally, and if not, explain how different participants are treated differently. If the lottery process is explained in a document or documents, please supply the document(s), and please supply representative examples of documents which persons use to enter the lottery.

RESPONSE:

Sandy Point adopted a lottery format as an unbiased vehicle for distributing water shares for residential connections to owners of real property in the Company's water service area when anticipated demand exceeded expected supply. For several years since the early 1990s, water availability has been extremely limited due to a moratorium on new water allocations and appeals of Water System Plan projections. In 2006 a lottery was held to distribute anticipated water shares. All property owners within the water service area were allowed one entry for each lot for which residential water was desired. An Intent to Build Form and \$1,500 per entry, plus an additional amount to bring their standby/base fees current if necessary, were required. Both SPIC shareholders and non-shareholders were eligible and followed the same guidelines. A random drawing was conducted by the accounting firm of Larson Gross, P.L.L.C. following the 2006 Annual Shareholders' Meeting. This firm also processed all entries, deposits, and notifications. An appeal of the Water System Plan caused a five-year delay in the implementation of the lottery results. Participants received full refunds, minus a \$100 administrative/processing fee, and retained their places in the lottery.

In January 2012, the Department of Health approved Sandy Point's 2011 Water System Plan Update, which allowed for 177 additional ERU connections. In May 2012, Sandy Point notified all owners of unserved original lottery properties that a new \$500 deposit and Intent to Build Form were required to remain in the lottery. Given the attrition among the first 177 entrants since the lottery drawing, Sandy Point was able to eventually offer connections to all 215 lottery participants. Sandy Point staff is currently receiving the \$1,000 balance of the hookup fee and building plans submittals and issuing Water Availability Notification Forms.

Please see attached Documents Produced in Response to Data Request No. 29. The lottery process may further be explained or discussed in Board meeting minutes over the years. Board meeting minutes are available for inspection upon request during the normal business hours at the offices of Sandy Point Improvement Company located at 4460 Decatur Drive, Ferndale 98248.

SUBJECT: WATER HOOKUP/LOTTERY

To: All Current and Future Water Customers

Hooray – Celebration Time !! Sandy Point Improvement Company has finally received authorization from the Washington State Department of Health for addition water connections at this time. The release of these hookups will allow us to fulfill the use of our 143 acre feet water right. The Board will continue to pursue other water right applications until we obtain water for a full build out at Sandy Point. The Board of Directors has consulted with the appropriate governmental agencies in regards to the guidelines for water distribution.

LOTTERY or LIMITED SUPPLY HOOKUP/CONNECTION:

All property owners within the Sandy Point service area are eligible to be awarded either a limited supply water connection or a residential construction connection. Only those water customers whose accounts are current and in good standing by 2:00 p.m., Thursday, August 31, will be eligible for the lottery.

Water customers are defined as those property owners who have been paying base fees. Those base fees have totaled \$5,000.00 to date. Property owners who have not been paying base fees may become a customer now by submitting payment in the form of a cashiers check or money order for \$5,000.00 per lot.

LIMITED SUPPLY HOOKUP:

The Board of Directors would like to know how many property owners are only interested in purchasing a "limited supply" and not a residential construction connection to their vacant property. If you would like to purchase a water connection for a "limited supply" connection (not for building at this time) you may do so by complying with and filling out the enclosed "Request for a Limited Supply Connection" form. Mail this form along with a cashiers check or money order made out to Sandy Point Improvement Company for a connection fee of \$500.00 to:

The \$500.00 represents the minimum fee for cost of the connection. Additional base fees may be required as provided on the "Request for a Limited Supply" form. The form and cashiers check or money order must be received by Larson Gross by 4:00 p.m., Monday, September 11, 2006. No exceptions.

A "Limited Supply" connection will provide water to the lot for an average of 15 gallons per day use limit. It is not enough water for a residential building permit. This will allow the Board to know how many connections will be available for the residential construction lottery. You may also submit your name for the lottery; however, if your name is drawn in the lottery, the "limited supply" connection must be returned to Sandy Point Improvement Company.

LOTTERY:

Connections for new residences will be awarded as a result of a lottery to be conducted by Larson Gross P.L.L.C. in accordance with the procedure set forth in the attached "Lottery Guidelines & Allocation of Whatcom County Water Availability Notification Forms" dated July 18, 2006. The lottery is scheduled for Saturday, September 30th, 2006, following the annual meeting at a Ferndale school location to be confirmed. The date and location is subject to change. All property owners eligible for the lottery will receive written confirmation of the date and location.

An entry fee for the lottery will be required, which represents the minimum water meter installation/connection fee. All except a \$100.00 administrative fee will be refundable to those that do not win the lottery draw. The entry fee will be deposited into a separate escrow account. To be eligible for the lottery a property owner must fill out and have met the conditions of an "Intent to Build" form. The "Intent to Build" form must be filed with Larson Gross by 4:00 p.m. Monday, September 11, 2006 to be eligible for the lottery.

Winners of the lottery will receive a "Water Availability Notification Form" when each winner has complied with the completion of terms for the building permit application process. If they do not perform within the criteria deadline the connection and the entry fee will be forfeited.

This notice is to publish the list of those awarded Whatcom County Water Availability Notification Forms (WANF) as a result of the lottery held on September 30, 2006. The lottery draws are listed on the enclosed list.

Because of the pending appeal of the water system plan, the Sandy Point Improvement Company Board has determined it in the best interest to not issue all WANFs made available from the approval of the water system plan. At this time 21 WANFs will be issued. Therefore, the first twenty one (those drawn #1 through #21) positions are authorized to proceed according to the enclosed guidelines. They must meet the requirements as set forth on the enclosed lottery guidelines #8 through #13 as approved July 18, 2006. A copy of those guidelines is enclosed.

Additional connections have become available because of a Board decision to disconnect a group of connections. Because this was a large number of disconnections the Department of Health has been closely involved and is asking for final documentation. There are up to 41 potential connections available as a result of disconnecting the group of customers. Up to eleven (11) of these potential connections were already committed, and therefore, upon completing the process with the Department of Health, 30 WANFs will be available and the next 30 (those drawn #22 through #51) positions will be authorized to proceed according to the enclosed guidelines.

A few additional WANFs may become available as those who received full connections return limited connections.

IMPORTANT NOTE: The timetable of events on the attached procedure is critical to being allowed to proceed with construction.

SUBJECT: 2006 WATER LOTTERY HOOKUP ALLOCATIONS

To all Water Lottery entrants:

On January 31, 2012, the Washington State Department of Health approved our 2012 Water System Plan (this is a State requirement). In that Water System Plan, we asked for and were granted the equivalent of 177 full residential hookups. © After waiting out the appeal period and verifying our rules and guidelines for the Lottery, we are now prepared to distribute those hookups.

As you may notice, there has been some time between this letter and the granting of hookups by the State. This has been due to waiting out the appeals period and the verification of property owners (there have been several changes in owners as well as lot consolidations). We wanted to make absolutely certain that all eligible and rightful owners were notified in a proper and timely manner. There are two shareholders who were granted water hookups in 1997 and assured by the Board of Directors at that time that they could exercise their water allotment at any time. There are also several shares that have to be awarded to shareholders who bought watered lots in the Heights and transferred them down to the Point. They also will be granted part of the 177 shares. We anticipate that we will ultimately have enough shares to go around, but the exact number will be revealed when we see the response to this letter.

If you have received this notice via registered mail, you are one of the eligible Lottery entrants and will be required to respond within the timelines set forth in the enclosed rules and guidelines.

If you have received this letter by regular mail, you are now on the alternate list meaning that if anyone in the first allocation of hookups chooses not to exercise their Lottery position, that hookup availability will go to the next property owner, via registered mail, in the order in which it was drawn in the Lottery. Please keep in mind that this alternate process could take in excess of one year.

Please be patient with this process as it will be quite time consuming for office staff, and continued calls to the office regarding your status will only slow the process.

Rules & Procedures

Now that you have received your notification of eligibility for a water hookup via registered mail, you will have until **July 31, 2012** to return the enclosed *Intent To Build* form, along with a cashier's check or money order payable to The Sandy Point Improvement Company for **\$500** (non-refundable deposit) <u>via registered mail</u> to:

Once you have submitted your *Intent To Build* form, along with your cashier's check or money order for \$500, you will have until May 31, 2013 to pick up your *WANF*. At that time you will need to submit your building plans to SPIC for review of the conservation measures and compliance with covenants. There may be an additional minimal fee charged for reviewing your plans. At that time the balance of the hookup fee is due in the form of a cashier's check or money order payable to The Sandy Point Improvement Company for \$1,000 (non-refundable).

All persons wishing to pick up their *WANF* must make an appointment with the office. You will then have one (1) year from date of issuance of your *WANF* to provide proof of application to Whatcom County for your building permit.

The WANF expires one (1) year from the date of submission of the Intent To Build form and is non-renewable. If you have not made application to Whatcom County for your building permit and the WANF expires, it will not be renewed and all monies paid will be forfeited.

A WANF is required by Whatcom County in order to secure a building permit. You will have three (3) years from submission of the *Intent To Build* form in which to obtain your building permit from Whatcom County.

Lottery Rules & Procedures for Allocation of Whatcom County Water Availability Notification Form (WANF)

If you are eligible and ready to build and would like to pick up your WANF right away, please contact the office to make an appointment. You will need to bring in a cashier's check or money order, payable to The Sandy Point Improvement Company for \$1,500 (non refundable) to receive your WANF.

Please note that the fee for the WANF (which is the basic connection cost) is \$1,500. This fee does not include any extra construction charges that may occur due to additional labor to install the water meter.

If you sell your property, the new owner shall be held to the same timelines that applied to the seller because the WANF goes with the property. There will be no exceptions.

Any lottery entrant whose property has not been charged the base fee will have to bring that base fee charge current prior to meter installation. That amount, through July 2012, is \$6,800. This figure will be adjusted in accordance with accumulated base fees if a later date is applicable.

If you have an outstanding account balance that is due the Sandy Point Improvement Company you must bring that past due amount current prior to issuance of the WANF. There will be no exceptions.


