Pend Oreille Telephone provides CPNI training to all of its new employees and in addition trains all of its existing employees on an annual basis. Pend Oreille Telephone Company also conducts subscriber outreach regarding CPNI by periodically placing CPNI explanation messages onto its website informing subscribers on CPNI rules and regulations. In addition Pend Oreille Telephone Company trains staff on Red Flag issues on an annual basis. All company employees are required to sign and acknowledge that they have completed CPNI and Red Flag training and understand obligations to adherence of applicable rules.

Pend Oreille Telephone Company also outlines its rates, terms, and conditions under which Pend Oreille Telephone Company offers service in its Local Exchange Tariff. The tariff explains customer rights and obligations, customer service, dispute resolution, deposits, billing and payment options, disconnection of service as well as cancellation of service options. Pend Oreille Telephone Company keeps its tariffs available for public inspection at its business offices.
