Suzanne Stillwell told me you had a question about applying for a permit. I asked her to convey that you needed to complete the application and send a letter explaining your circumstances. I looked a bit more into it, and, in the interest of saving Mike Dotson and you some emails, I'm going to direct you to some WACs: 480-07-110; 480-14-020, -180, and -250; 480-15-035, -186, -302, and -305; and WAC 480-70-006, and -091. I can't give you legal advice, but I can say that it looks like Dolly needs to request an exemption from some of the Commission's rules. The cites I just provided should get you started (I can't say the list is exhaustive, especially with solid waste).
