21 Pursuant to the proceedings at the prehearing conference held in these dockets on May
22 16, 2001, Winstar Wireless, Inc., and Teligent Services, Inc., urge the Commission to require
23 Qwest and Verizon to file proposed terms and conditions for microwave collocation on or
24 before June 22, 2001, for the reasons set forth herein and at the prehearing conference. Qwest
25 and Verizon have both indicated that they agree that they are required to propose terms and

conditions¹. The establishment of a deadline is necessary to ensure that this important issue is addressed and resolved in a fair and expeditious manner and in accordance with the Commission's August 3, 2000 Fifth Supplemental Order in Docket No. UT-003013.

The proposed deadline of June 22, 2001 is reasonable and would afford more than sufficient time for Qwest and Verizon to complete and file their proposals. Qwest and Verizon have established terms and conditions for microwave collocation in other states that offer models for their Washington proposals, and each has been aware for several months that it would be required to propose terms and conditions for microwave collocation in Washington.

Therefore, the Commission should order Qwest and Verizon to file proposed terms and conditions for microwave collocation on or before June 22, 2001.
