RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Cascade Natural Gas Corporation, Docket UG-200568

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On May 18, 2021, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 05, Rejecting Tariff Sheets; Authorizing and Requiring Compliance Filing (Order 05) in the above-referenced docket. Order 05, among other things, required Cascade Natural Gas Corporation (Cascade) to decrease its revenue requirement by approximately \$0.39 million or 0.15 percent.¹

On May 21, 2021, Cascade filed with the Commission gas tariff sheets reflecting the results of Order 05. On May 25, 2021, Cascade filed with the Commission a Petition for Reconsideration of Order 05 (Petition). On May 27, 2021, the Commission provided notice that parties to the proceeding could respond to the petition by June 4, 2021. Also on May 27, 2021, Cascade filed a letter requesting to change the proposed rate effective date of the tariff sheets to July 1, 2021.

On June 18 2021, the Commission issued Order 06, Denying Petion for Reconsideration In Part; Granting In Part; Modifying Final Order 05 (Order 06).

Commission Staff (Staff) reviewed the Company's compliance filing dated June 11, 2021. Staff believes that the tariff revisions contained therein comply with Commission Order 05, entered May 18, 2021 and Commission Order 06, entered June 18, 2021.
