Dear Ms. Washburn:

Order No. 1 in this proceeding, the Prehearing Conference Order, directed that Cascade Natural Gas Corporation ("Cascade") provide documentation for the restrictions on use of the cost of service ("COS") study included in Cascade's direct case. As described at the prehearing conference and reported at ¶ 9 of Order No. 1, the model is proprietary, not Cascade-owned, and Cascade lacks the rights to make the model available to the parties' use to permit them to enter proposed changes to the model and determine the result.

The computer model, TACOS Gold, was developed by Cascade's COS witness, Lamar Maxwell Dickey and his associate, Dan Drummond. The current version was developed for use on a personal computer and was completed in 1998. Earlier versions ran on main frames and/or micro-computers and were developed starting in 1977. All versions of the model have been used in developing cost allocation studies that have been presented by Mr. Dickey before numerous regulatory agencies. *Dickey, Exhibit No.* \_\_\_ (LMD-1T) at 15.

According to Mr. Dickey, the TACOS Gold program can be leased for a fee of \$20,000. Purchasing of a copy of the program would authorize the licensee to use the program, but would not authorize the licensee to pass the program along to another party or to change the program in any way. Attached is a copy of a "License Agreement for TACOS Gold." The License Agreement provides that the software, if purchased, cannot "be given away, installed on nonowned computers or loaned to other parties."

As described at the prehearing conference, Cascade will make Mr. Dickey available to run the model with the specifications and assumptions prescribed by Staff, Public Counsel or an intervenor, with the output produced thereby provided to the requesting party. The associated costs would be paid by the Cascade and recorded as a rate case expense in this proceeding.
