Re: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Puget Sound Energy, Docket UE-200980

TO ALL PARTIES:

On June 1, 2021, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 05; Final Order Approving and Adopting Settlement Agreement (Order 05) in this docket. Order 05, among other things, required Puget Sound Energy (PSE or Company) to make a compliance filing inclding revised tariff sheets in compliance with Order 05.

On June 17, 2021, PSE filed its revised electric tariff sheets and a revised Exhibit A-1, showing an increase to the proposed variable power costs baseline rate, with an effective date of July 1. The compliance filing also included an increase in the annual electric Home Energy Lifeline Program (HELP) funding to be effective October 1, 2021.

On June 29, 2021, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter informing the Commission that Staff had reviewed the compliance filing and believes that it complies with Order 05.

The Commission has reviewed the compliance filing of June 17, 2021, and finds that it complies with the requirements of Order 05. The electric tariff sheets and variable power costs baseline rate filed on June 17, 2021, will become effective on July 1, 2021. The increase in HELP funding through Schedule 129 will become effective on October 1, 2021.
