The purpose of this filing is to comply with the Commission's Order No. 06: Final Order Rejecting Tariff Sheets; Authorizing and Requiring Compliance Filing; Requiring Subsequent Filing in Docket Nos. UG-040640, UE-040641, UE-031471 and UE-032043 (the "Order"). The attached revised tariff sheets reflect the form and rates authorized in the Order.

The Partial Settlement Agreement adopted by the Order includes an electric service schedule (Schedule 40) that was not included in the original filing but was agreed to and approved as part of the Partial Settlement Agreement. Pursuant to that settlement, the Company submitted Schedule 40 to the

Commission on December 22, 2004. In that filing, the Company advised that substitute sheets would be required to set forth the proper Schedule 40 rate once the Commission issued its Order in Docket Nos. UG-040640 et al. PSE is submitting at the same time as this compliance filing the necessary substitute sheets for Schedule 40. The balance of the changes included in the Partial Settlement Agreement is included in this compliance filing.

The Partial Settlement Agreement envisioned that Schedule 40 would become effective at approximately the same time as the rates approved in the Order. Due to procedural considerations associated with the timing of the Commission's Open Meeting schedule and issuance of the Order, the parties agreed to delay implementation of the Schedule 40 rate until the Commission could formally approve the substitute rates for Schedule 40 at the March 16, 2005, Open Meeting of the Commission.

Work papers that demonstrate the derivation of the rates proposed to be changed by the enclosed tariff sheets are attached. As required by WAC 480-07-883(2) a copy of this filing has been served on each party to this proceeding.

The enclosed tariff sheets reflect issue dates of February 25, 2005, and effective dates of March 4, 2005, by authority of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission in Docket Nos. UG-040640, UE-040641, UE-031471 and UE-032043 (Consolidated).

Also enclosed are the final exhibits supporting the Company's baseline rate established in this consolidated proceeding. Please note that the unredacted version of Exhibit A-4, provided herewith in the sealed envelope, is ***Confidential per Protective Order in WUTC Docket Nos. UG-040640 et al.***
