BACKGROUND

1 On February 9, 2022, Beeline Tours LTD., d/b/a Seattle Express (the Company), filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting an extension of authority under certificate of public convenience and necessity C001052 to provide the following service:

DOOR-TO-DOOR PASSENGER SERVICE BETWEEN: Seattle-Tacoma International Airport, downtown Seattle and the Seattle Cruise Piers.

SCHEDULED PASSENGER SERVICE BETWEEN: Seattle-Tacoma International Airport, downtown Seattle and the Seattle Cruise Piers.

2 On February 14, 2022, the Company contacted the Commission to revise the application for extension of authority under certificate of public convenience and necessity C001052 to provide the following service:

SCHEDULED PASSENGER SERVICE BETWEEN: Seattle-Tacoma International Airport and the Seattle Cruise Piers.

3 The application appeared on the February 15, 2022, application docket.

4 In support of its request to extend its authority, the Company provided several letters from members of the tourism and hospitality industries in the greater Seattle area. The letters indicate a need for service that is not adequately served in this area.

5 On March 16, 2022, an objection to the application was filed on behalf of Pacific Northwest Transportation Services, Inc. d/b/a Premier Airport Shuttle; Capital

Aeroporter. This objection was subsequently withdrawn on May 3, 2022, by Pacific Northwest Transportation Services, Inc. No other objections were filed.

6 After reviewing the application, Commission Staff (Staff) determined that the application complies with the Commission's requirements for permanent auto transportation authority and recommends that the Commission grant the Company's application.

DISCUSSION AND DECISION

7 The Commission, having considered the application and being fully advised, finds that the Company is fit, willing, and able to provide the proposed extended service and that the proposed service extension is necessary and will be a convenience to the public.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:


8 (1) The application for an extension of authority filed by the Company in this docket is granted. The Company's certificate C001052 is amended as provided in Appendix A to this order.
