NOTICE SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

RE: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Cascade Natural Gas Corporation, Docket PG-150120

TO ALL PARTIES:

On July 12, 2016, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) filed a Formal Complaint against Cascade Natural Gas Corporation (Cascade), alleging Cascade violated Order 01 in this docket, entered February 12, 2015, and failed to maintain required records or documentation.

On September 2, 2016, the Commission convened a prehearing conference before Administrative Law Judge Marguerite E. Friedlander and issued Order 02, Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing Set for March 22, 2017.

On November 23, 2016, the Commission's regulatory staff (Staff) sent an email to Cascade and Judge Friedlander indicating that the parties had reached a tentative settlement. Staff stated its intent to file the settlement agreement and all supporting documents by December 15, 2016.

Pending receipt of the all-party settlement agreement and supporting documentation, the Commission finds good cause to suspend the procedural schedule.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the Commission suspends the procedural schedule in this docket.
