1 Qwest Corporation ("Qwest"), Commission Staff and Public Counsel, by this motion, request that the Commission approve the parties' proposed AFOR implementation plan for Qwest in this docket. The proposed plan is included as an attachment to the motion. It is intended to provide an effective date and a review date for the AFOR and timelines, consistent with the Commission's prior orders, for carrying out the customer notices and reporting measures required by the Commission under the approved AFOR. The proposed implementation plan does not alter any of the Commission's prior requirements regarding the content of such notices and reports.

2 Qwest, Staff, and Public Counsel are in agreement on all items in the proposed implementation plan. The plan has also been provided to the intervening parties, and they have not raised any objections to its provisions. We therefore request that it be approved by the Commission.
