TO ALL PARTIES:

On May 18, 2021, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 05 Rejecting Tariff Sheets; Authorizing and Require Compliance Filing in the above-referenced docket. Order 05, among other things, required Cascade Natural Gas Corporation ("Cascade" or "Company") to file a Disconnection Reduction Plan.

On May 18, 2022, Cascade filed with the Commission its Disconnection Reduction Plan. The Company's Report shows, among other things, its existing payment options and available arrangements, low-income advisory group process, energy assistance offerings, low-income assistance analysis, and preventative disconnection process.

On July 27, 2022, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter stating that it had reviewed the report. In its letter, Staff stated that it believes the Company has fully complied with Order 05.

The Commission has reviewed the Company's Disconnection Reduction Plan and finds that the report complies with Order 05.
