Dear Administrative Law Judge Rendahl:

I have been considering the effect of the FCC's Order released May 1, 2008, under FCC 08-122. At Paragraph 38 of that Order, the FCC states as follows: "Specifically, for each state, the annual interim cap shall be set at twelve times the level of support that all competitive ETCs were eligible to receive in that state for the month of March, 2008." As a result of the establishment of this interim cap on the amount of support that competitive ETCs may receive, designation of an additional competitive ETC means that other competitive ETCs in the state will receive less in the way of a draw from the USF. This means that existing competitive ETCs may have a direct financial interest in the designation of additional competitive ETCs.

Obviously, this was not an issue at the time the initial pre-hearing conference in this matter was held on April 23, 2008. The Commission may want to give consideration to holding another pre-hearing conference to allow existing competitive ETCs the opportunity to intervene in the proceeding. They may not be interested. However, no one knows at this juncture whether they are or are not interested.
