- On January 13, 2010, the City of Fife filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a Petition to open a pedestrian only atgrade rail crossing at 54th Avenue East in Fife. On January 12, 2010, Union Pacific Railroad (UPR or Railroad) opposed the proposed crossing modification.
- By Order 02, Prehearing Conference Order, entered May 20, 2010, the Commission adopted a procedural schedule and set this matter for hearing. The procedural schedule has been modified three times upon request by all parties.¹
- On November 30, 2010, the parties filed a joint motion for continuance of evidentiary hearing and modification of procedural schedule. The parties state that they met on November 29, 2010, to discuss the potential for settlement and agreed that they needed additional time to exchange and evaluate potential settlement options. The parties concur that postponing all deadlines in this matter by approximately 30 days will assist them in this endeavor.
- 4 According to WAC 480-07-385, the Commission will grant a continuance if the requesting party demonstrates good cause and the continuance will not prejudice any party or the Commission. Affording all parties additional time to consider settlement options constitutes good cause and neither the parties nor the Commission will be

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prejudiced by extending the procedural schedule and hearings in this matter by approximately 30 days. However, the Commission concludes that it would be reasonable to relocate the public comment hearing to Olympia to conserve Commission time and resources. The Commission will ensure that its conference bridge line is available to allow members of the public to telephonically participate in this hearing.
