RE: In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment against 3Z Movers, LLC, in the amount of \$1,900, Dockets TV-180198 and TV-190037 (Consolidated)

TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 20, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 03/01, Order of Consolidation; Approving Safety Management Plan; Imposing Penalty (Order 03/01). Order 03/01 required 3Z Movers, LLC, (3Z Movers or Company) to pay a \$1,900 penalty for violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-15. On March 26, 2019, the Commission entered Order 04/02, Granting Payment Arrangement (Order 04/02). Among other provisions, Order 04/02 approved a payment plan permitting 3Z Movers to pay the \$1,900 penalty in 19 monthly installments, the first of which was due on April 8, 2019. To date, 3Z Movers has made 13 timely payments and is in good standing.

Due to the economic impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Commission exercises its discretion to suspend the Company's payment plan for a period of six months. Accordingly, the remaining installments are due as follows:
