
Journeyman Wage Adjustment

The Company and Union agree that the ability to attract and retain employees in certain journeyman classifications has significantly changed since these wage rates were addressed at PSE. Therefore, in order to attract and retain quality journeymen in those positions, the Company and the Union agree, subject to union ratification, that the following classification wages shall be adjusted effective August 28, 2006, as follows:
