Just a follow up on the progression of requirements, per your December 19, 2000 letter.

The trucking of water was completed on January 15, 2001.

The deepened well #2 was placed on line January 15, 2001.

The February 7, 2001 MPA test was canceled due to a lack of water at well #2.

The well #2 as of February 14th has recovered water from Alderlake for operation.

The first MPA test is scheduled for April 2, 2001.

The design for the installation of the disinfection facility should be ready for submittal next week.
