As an Avista customer, I express my strongest objection to the proposal that Puget Sound Energy be allowed to sell its share of the extremely polluting Colstrip Unit 4. Such a sale, if permitted to go forward, would allow Unit 4 to emit an amount of carbon dioxide equivalent to the emissions of 1,000,000 per year until at least 2039 instead of 2025. In addition, NorthWest, the entity that would buy Colstrip, would then be able to force Avista customers to pay for health-damaging pollution that they do not want. Further financial losses are likely to be inflicted on Avista customers by their being required to pay a share of the estimated 1 billion dollars of clean-up costs.
