BACKGROUND

- 1 On January 31, 2001, the Commission entered its Thirteenth Supplemental Order in Part A of this proceeding and resolved issues relating to certain compliance filings. The Order in Part A required Verizon Northwest, Inc., to submit certain compliance filings by February 21, 2001.
- 2 Verizon, on February 21, 2001, filed Advice Nos. 970 and 971 containing tariff revisions for its Tariff Nos. WN U-21 and WN U-22.
- 3 The Commission, in its Nineteenth Supplemental Order dated May 15, 2001, rejected Advice Nos. 970 and 971, and directed Verizon to refile tariffs consistent with the Order no later than ten days after the Order date.
- 4 On May 25, 2001, Verizon filed Advices 986 and 987 containing tariff revisions for its Tariff Nos. WN U-21 and WN U-22 and represented that the tariffs are in compliance with paragraph 8 of the Nineteenth Supplemental Order. These include the following pages:

5 Commission Staff has reviewed the Verizon compliance tariff filing and states that it appears to comply in all substantive respects with the Commission’s Order. No other party filed comments within the permitted time.

6 On May 30, 2001 the Commission granted a request from Verizon for an effective date for the compliance filings of not less than 15 days after it submitted the filings.

7 The Commission finds that the tariff revisions filed with the Commission by Verizon Northwest, Inc., on May 25, 2001, are consistent with the Commission’s Nineteenth Supplemental Order and therefore concludes that the substance of the tariff revisions should be approved as filed for effect on June 18, 2001.

**ORDER**

THE COMMISSION ORDERS That:

8 The tariff revisions filed by Verizon on May 25, 2001, in accordance with the  
Nineteenth Supplemental Order in this proceeding, shall become effective as filed on  
June 18, 2001.


9 THE COMMISSION ORDERS FURTHER That it retains jurisdiction over the
