The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission Staff (Staff) moves to dismiss allegations against Advanced TelCom, Inc., d/b/a/Advanced TelCom Group (ATG) and Qwest Corporation (Qwest) relating to the March 15, 2001, and January 30, 2002, agreements listed on Exhibit A to the complaint.

Staff has investigated the allegations relating to this agreement and has determined that the March 15, 2001, agreement primarily addresses terms and conditions for service in the state of Oregon. Staff does not believe the provisions referencing operations in the state of Washington constitute an interconnection agreement that must be filed with the Commission.
