BACKGROUND

On December 6, 2000, Pearson, Sharyn & Zepp Linda, C-993, d/b/a Centralia-SeaTac Airport Express, LLC (Centralia-SeaTac) filed with the Commission revisions to its currently effective Tariff No. 1 designated as 6th Revised Page 4 and 9th Revised Page 2. The stated effective date was January 6, 2001.

The filing would increase charges and rates for service provided by Centralia-SeaTac. Because those increases might injuriously affect the rights and interests of the public and Centralia-SeaTac had not demonstrated that such increases would result in rates that are fair, just, and reasonable, the Commission on December 27, 2000, entered a Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revisions.

On April 17, 2001, Centralia-SeaTac filed a letter with the Commission requesting to withdraw the tariff revisions filed in this docket.

FINDINGS

- 1. Centralia-SeaTac is an auto transportation company and is a public service company subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.
- 2. From all indications, it appears to be in the public interest to grant Centralia-SeaTac's request and to dismiss the Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revisions.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

1. The tariff revisions filed in this docket on December 6, 2000, are withdrawn.
