Dear Ms. Washburn:

The prehearing conference order in the above-referenced docket establishes a briefing schedule to address the issues raised and requires opening briefs from both parties on May 10. In light of recent events, Focal Communications Corporation of Washington ("Focal") wants to try to negotiate a resolution to these issues but needs additional time to undertake those negotiations. I have spoken with Kimberly Newman, counsel for Verizon Northwest Inc. ("Verizon"), who informed me that Verizon shares this desire and concern.

Accordingly, Focal requests that the Commission suspend the briefing schedule and any further proceedings in this case pending further notification from the parties to enable Focal and Verizon to engage in good faith negotiations to resolve Focal's Petition.
