Amendment One To the Qwest Site Agreement To The Supplemental Work Order 04-01 Contract Number T02-TSD-319 For Advanced Transport Services is effective upon execution by both parties and upon the approval of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission. Basic contract Number T02-TSD-319, Docket UT-040241, was approved on February 25, 2004 and became effective on February 26, 2004.

Description of Service:

The underlying service contract provides Wide Area Network (WAN) Ethernet (a local area network design employing CSMA/CD as its access control mechanism connections) to various locations within the State of Washington.

TELECOMMUNICATIONS CONTRACTS: 480-80-142 (7)
