- 2. This protest is filed on behalf of WRRA, its members at large and on behalf of that member or those members who hold authority to collect and transport solid waste within the territory specified in the above-referenced application.

Members of WRRA are presently serving the areas requested in the above-referenced application pursuant certificates of public convenience and necessity issued by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission.
