- On September 21, 2004, CWA, Inc. filed an application (No. D-079309) for an extension of Certificate No. C-01073 for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Operate Motor Vehicles in Furnishing Passenger and Express Service as an Auto Transportation Company (Application). Notice of the Application was published in the Commission's weekly Docket of October 11, 2004.
- The Application requests that its authority to serve between Yakima, Ellensburg, Cle Elum and the Seattle-Tacoma International Airport and the Seattle Amtrak station be revised to include passenger service between Yakima, Ellensburg, and Cle Elum. The Commission received no protests within the 20 days required by WAC 480-30-032(1). RCW 81.68.040 requires that the Commission grant authority in a territory already served only after hearing.
- The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter under Title 81 RCW, have legal authority to regulate persons seeking to furnish auto transportation services under chapters 81.68 RCW and 480-30 WAC. The statutes involved include those

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within chapter 81.04 RCW, chapter 81.28 RCW and chapter 81.68 RCW, including but not limited to RCW 81.68.030 and RCW 81.68.040. Rules involved include those within chapters 480-30 WAC and 480-07 WAC.

- The Commission sets a prehearing conference to discuss preliminary matters, the hearing process, and to formulate the issues. The issues in this proceeding include whether the issuance of an extension of authority to CWA, Inc., for the service it proposes, is necessary and is otherwise consistent with the public interest. Further, a purpose of the prehearing conference is to discuss whether proceedings should be consolidated with Docket No. TC-041353.
- THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That a prehearing conference in this matter will be held at 9:30 a.m., on December 8, 2004, in the Commission's Hearing Room, Second Floor, Chandler Plaza Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington. The prehearing conference will convene at the same time as a prehearing conference in Docket No. TC-041353. If you are unable to attend the prehearing conference in person, you may attend via the Commission 's teleconference bridge line, 360-664-3846. Please appear on the teleconference bridge five minutes before the conference is scheduled to begin.
- THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that any party who fails to attend or participate in the prehearing conference set by this Notice, or any other stage of this proceeding, may be held in default in accordance with RCW 34.05.440. The parties are further advised that the sanction provisions of WAC 480-07-450 are specifically invoked.
