
I have received the notice of hearing, set for April 25, 2007 at 9:30 a.m, to consider the complaint of TLC Moving and Storage, Inc. v. TLC Transitions, LLC d/b/a Worry-free Moving. I wish to make you aware of a number of changes in the underlying situation pertaining to this case.

TLC Transitions, LLC d/b/a Worry-free Moving has decided to change its name. The name of the Limited Liability Company has been changed to Expert Services with the Secretary of State and the trade name has been changed to Total Transitions with the Department of Licensing. As you can see, there is no vestige of "TLC" anywhere in our new naming plan. On Thursday, March 22, I received a message from Tina Leipski of the Licensing Division of the Washington UTC to the effect that she had confirmed both these changes and would be issuing a provisional permit in the new name as soon as she received verification of the proper insurance in the new name. I have requested the company's insurance agent to make these changes.

With the changes described above, it seems that the hearing scheduled for April 25th is no longer necessary, that either the complainant could withdraw the complaint or the UTC might declare the hearing unnecessary. I certainly am prepared to come to the hearing that is scheduled, but it would seem that the basis for the complaint is now moot.

Please advise me regarding any changes to the planned April 25th hearing.
