Discussion

Today's presentation allows customers or other interested parties to comment on the proposed rates in Docket TG-071785. No action is required by the commission. Staff will make its recommendation to the commission at the open meeting on October 10, 2007.

On August 31, 2007, Waste Management of Washington, Inc., d/b/a Brem-Air Disposal (Brem-Air), filed a general rate increase for solid waste service and rates for a new residential curbside recycling service. Kitsap County ordinance 379-2007 has mandated that a single stream curbside recycling program be implemented by October 1, 2007. Brem-Air serves approximately 42,000 regulated residential and commercial customers in Kitsap County. The last general rate increase has been in effect since 2001. The overall impact of the filing will be approximately \$861,700 (6.56 percent). The major drivers of the proposed revision are increases in labor, benefits and fuel expenses. All other expense categories with the exception of disposal fees have increased at varying levels since the last increase.

The commission has received 14 comments from customers against the proposed increase. A count of issues from these customers is as follows:
