This letter is to notify you of proposed rate increases for our commercial services within the areas of King County, if approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC).

The proposed rate increase is needed because the Company has incurred increased costs, primarily labor and fuel costs. **If approved, the proposed rates will become effective August 1, 2008.**
