Dear Mr. Brooks:

On November 3, 2008, Inland Telephone Company (Inland) and Charter Fiberlink WA – CCVII, LLC (Charter) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) a request for approval of an interconnection agreement. The agreement is a delegated item scheduled for approval by February 1, 2009.

WAC 480-07-640 requires interconnection agreements be submitted for approval within 30 days after the agreement is signed. The filing is 31 days late. The commission reserves the right to investigate, and if appropriate, commence a separate proceeding to complain, enforce, and penalize Inland for failure to meet the filing requirements. A similar letter has been sent to Charter.
