Thank you for your letter of November 20, 2009 regarding our Response for the Pullman/Clarkston Standard Inspection report. We are writing to follow up on the remaining outstanding items.

1. Item 3, Finding A, Pullman Meter Less Riser Documentation.

As requested, please find documentation for the Atmospheric Corrosion Inspection of meter less (idle) risers for the Pullman district attached.

2. Item 3, Finding B, Atmospheric Corrosion Inspections.

Avista has begun to make significant improvements to the training document relating to the Atmospheric Corrosion Prevention Program. The improvements will reflect greater attention to conditions between the service valve and ground surface, especially at the air-to-soil interface. The new procedures will require that disbonded wrap be removed so that a thorough investigation may be conducted into the condition of the pipe. The Program training document revisions will be completed by March 1, 2010.
