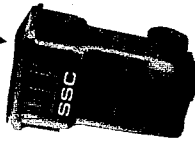

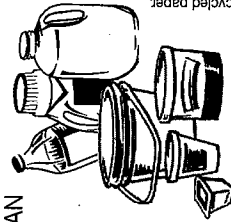

Proposed rates for the most common services are listed below. The total rate increase is approximately 7.0% (2.0% garbage disposal fee increase effective July 1 and 5.0% garbage collection fee increase effective August 1) depending on your service. The actual rates, if approved by the UTC, may either be higher or lower than those proposed. If this request is approved by the UTC, the new rates would become effective August 1, 2009, and would apply to all commercial and multi-family garbage collection customers in Bellingham and unincorporated Whatcom County.

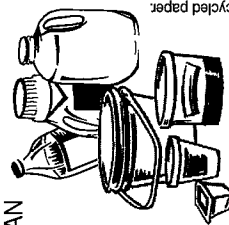
