Fuel index prices have increased from \$1.9274 per gallon for the base period to \$2.7254 per gallon current price. Proposed changes are to add a Special Fuel Surcharge Supplement No. 12 in the amount of 1.37%.

3. The temporary 1.37% fuel surcharge in all rates and charges is the result of increased fuel costs incurred by the company during the months of August 2009 and September 2009, to be collected from customers as follows:
