3. The temporary .93% fuel surcharge in all rates and charges is the result of increased fuel costs incurred by the company during the months of October 2009 and November 2009, to be collected from customers as follows:

For customers who are billed monthly for services in arrears, the fuel surcharge applies to all services provided in the months of January 2010 and February 2010.
