The company requests Commission approval to amend its filed Tariff Number 3 on Less the Statutory Notice to include a Special Fuel Surcharge Tariff Supplement to recover the rising cost of fuel. Fuel index prices have increased from \$1.87 per gallon for the base period to \$2.97 per gallon current price. Proposed changes are to add a Special Fuel Surcharge Supplement No. 9 in the amount of 1.22%. These numbers are directly off the staffs Fuel Surcharge Worksheet for solid waste.


For customers who are billed monthly for services in arrears, the fuel surcharge applies to all services provided in the months of July, August and September 2010.
