Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on June 30, 2010, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("commission") issued a Penalty Assessment against AAA Moving & Storage, Inc., ("AAA") in the amount of \$200 for violation of WAC 480-15-480, which requires household goods carriers to file an annual report with the commission by May 1 each year. AAA has failed to file its annual reports for both 2008 and 2009, and has incurred a penalty of \$100 per violation. The commission sent AAA a Second Notice on August 20, 2010, and a Final Notice on September 20, 2010.

The commission has not received the \$200 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$200 balance.
