RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment No. UT-101042

Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on June 30, 2010, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against EMAN Networks in the amount of \$200 for violation of WAC 480-120-382, which requires competitively classified telecommunications companies to file annual reports with the commission by May 1 each year. EMAN Networks failed to file its 2008 annual report in a timely manner, and has failed to file its 2009 annual report. EMAN Networks has incurred a penalty of \$100 for each violation. The commission sent EMAN Networks a Second Notice on August 20, 2010, and a Final Notice on September 20, 2010.

The commission has not received the \$200 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$200 balance.
